Finance Report

Dick R. presented the Finance Report starting with the Balance Sheet. He reported that we have 403,000+ in assets as of this month. Also reported was the fact that the Capital Campaign is continuing to grow. Pledged money is still coming in. Continuing with the report Dick presented the Income and Expense report. We have 148,785.00 in pledged income making our total above last year at this time. Our

expenses continue to be below what was reported last year. We are having a strong year with +32,500.00 greater than last year.

BBQ and Taco Dinner

July 9 will be our first taco dinner at Good Shepherd. The sale will start at 4 PM and continue until the meals are gone. Since this is uncharted territory for us we are not sure how many meals we should order. There will be 2 different types of tacos, beef and chicken, with 2 sides included.
